



## **J. T. Barker Scholarship 'Ad Lucem'**

Jonathan Tyler Barker died in 1872, however, continues to live through his commitment to the youth of Boxford. His will left a trust that would contribute to building a free school in West Boxford which educated many whose ancestors still live in Boxford today. Though the Boxford Free School closed its doors in 1917, the trust continues today supporting education 'to the light'. Saint George Classical Academy is incredibly grateful to be the recipient of a \$10,000 grant which has been allocated toward offering scholarship money for Boxford families to attend Saint George Classical Academy.
